


KiwiRail Traction Overhead Wires Safety Behaviours and Electrocution Risks

GENERAL SAFETY*

You need these TWO permits:

- Permit to Enter KiwiRail land #
- Electrical Permit to Work




Use Marker posts to give emergency location



Personnel must be trained or supervised




Give the Electrical Permit to Work to the Person in Charge




ELECTROCUTION HAZARD – you might lose your life!

You can stand on:


- Wagon decks
- Diesel loco running boards... but nothing above your head level




Smoke can conduct electricity




Don't climb on loads and high sided rolling stock under the overhead




Carry long objects lengthways NOT up and down




You may conduct electricity if you touch derailed vehicles that still touch the overhead




You may conduct electricity if you touch both sides of broken bonds or rails



Loose or flapping loads on vehicles will conduct electricity or damage overhead wires



Direct water/fluids/CO2 and dry powder down and away from overhead wires



IF IN DOUBT ASK!

Keep clear of anything hanging from the overhead
