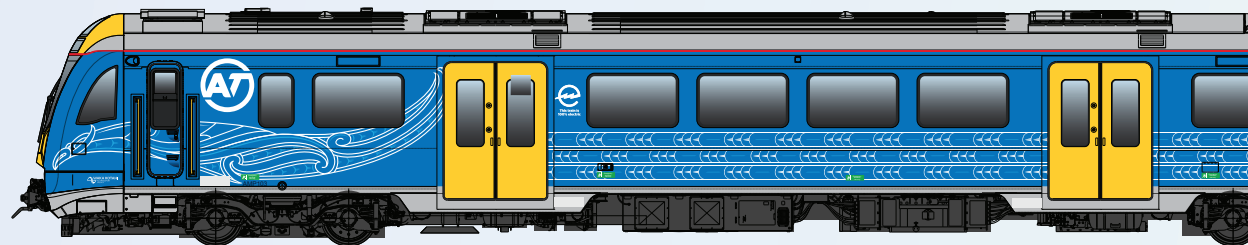




AUCKLAND'S EMU FLEET

TRAINSPOTTER CHALLENGE

Auckland One Rail runs Auckland's metro rail network with 95 EMUs (Electric Multiple Units).
How many can you spot?



Fancy yourself a bit of a trainspotter?

- Look at the side of the train near the front of each carriage and you'll see a unique serial code: **AMA**, **AMT** or **AMP**, followed by a 3-4 digit number. 'AM' stands for **Auckland Metro**, while **T** = **Trailer Car**, **A** = **Auxiliary** and **P** = **Pantograph/Power**. The number is the train's unique identifier.
- Tick them off as you see them across the network.
